Course attendance prerequisites

Candidate must have a valid glider pilot licence and have completed 125 solo flights and accumulated at least 20 hours solo time in gliders; or 75 flights and 15 hours solo time if holding a Private Pilot Licence – aeroplanes; or 25 flights and 10 hours solo time if holding Flight Instructor Rating – aeroplanes. For winch-launched pilots, increase number of glider flights by 50%. The candidate should be trained and checked to fly passengers from the back seat and must have satisfactorily completed the SAC Bronze Badge.
